

Clifford has had a tremendous impact on our 4-H shooting sports program. His dedication to the program is second to none, he has selflessly given up his own time and money to help support and build the program from scratch. Without Clifford our shooting sports program would be nowhere close to what it is today. His time and effort have left a lasting impact on not only the program but every 4-H member who has participated in it. Our youth have not only learned about shooting and marksmanship from Clifford but have learned leadership skills that will last a lifetime.

Deadline to email pictures June 25th

June Category: Night

Photos that capture objects in or against the night sky. Photos can include objects such as buildings, landscape features, people, light trails, etc. seen at night. Object seen in the night sky such as stars or planets are also acceptable. The use of a telescope is permitted.

Examples: Milky Way, meteor shower, moon, cityscape at night Not Allowed: Sunset and sunrise photos
