Wheeler County 4-H Shooting Sports Shooter Conduct & Safety

Welcome to the Wheeler County 4-H Gun Club. Observe the following at all times—no exceptions:

- Club is only for Wheeler County 4-H Shooters or an event affiliated with 4-H.
- Payments and identification is required for any event where shooters are not Wheeler County 4-H members.
- NO SHOT SIZE LARGE THAN 12 ga., 7 1/2 target load on AGC property at any time. NO three inch (3") or "magnum" shells. (i.e., 71/2, 8, 8 1/2, 9 target loads only) _____ initial here
- 'Riot' guns or shotguns with 22" or shorter barrels and extended or combat magazines WILL NOT BE PERMITTED on any field at The Wheeler County 4-H Gun Club. (With the exceptions of youth type smaller gauge pump or auto loaded for kids).
- No pistols at any time
- Guns must be <u>open and unloaded at all times</u> unless actively on a shooting post, **pointed downrange**. Guns must be open/unloaded when changing posts. "the only real safety is an unloaded, open gun."
- No extra shells in any gun at any time.
- Shooting is allowed only on active fields, during fully staffed operating hours.
- Eye and ear protection is mandatory.
- Keep noise and talking to a minimum near voice release; turn off voice releases after shooting.
- No shooting after consumption of an alcoholic beverage or drugs—no alcoholic beverages or drugs on or near the premises of Wheeler County 4-H Gun Club.
- Stop and report unsafe activity immediately. "See it, stop it, report it"
- Observe common sense gun safety and good sportsmanship at all times.
- <u>Pay for all rounds before leaving the facility.</u> Unpaid rounds are stolen rounds. Members are responsible for the conduct of (and payment for) their guests.

VIOLATION OF WHEELER COUNTY 4-H GUN CLUB SAFETY RULES OR THOSE OF ANY SANCTIONING BODY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EJECTION FROM OUR GROUNDS OR DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY WHEELER COUNTY 4-H SHOOTING SPORTS BOARD MEMBERS.
